Savigny-Lès-Beaune 1er Cru "Les Peuillets" 2018

History

The Domaine des Riottes in Meursault, which owns four hectares of vines, offers a lovely range of Côte de Beaune wines.

Grape variety

Pinot Noir

Origin

In the Northwest of the Côte de Beaune. The vineyards surround the picturesque village of Savigny-lès-Beaune. The Climat "Les Peuillets" is adjacent to the Beaune appellation.

Vinification

Traditional vinification in thermo-regulated stainless steel. Prefermentation - temperature controlled cold maceration. Long fermentation during which pigeages and pumping over are performed. Aged in oak barrels for 15 months. 40% new oak and 60% oak barrels used between 1 and 3 times. The oak is mainly sourced from the Vosges region.

Soil

The soil is composed of limestone mixed with clay.



Colour

Of a deep red cherry colour.



Nose

The nose of black and red fresh fruits and violet.



Palate

The palate is wide and generous, aromatic with light spices. The tannins are fine and delicate.

Recommandations

Ideal with meat: beef pieces, roasts, poultry or even foie gras. Cheeses with a sweet taste: Chaource, Brie de Meaux, Tomme, Mont d'Or...
